A video surveillance conducted by the FBI in August 1990 reveals 4732

 IVAN MCGHEE), CHRIS JOHNSON (CHILDS) and WILLIAM EARL GILBERT 4735
 (the fifth male was not identified) were observed on the Trout 4736
 Creek Pass property. At 1:30 p.m., WILLIAM EARL GILBERT, accom- 4737
 panied by six young male children proceeded to do physical exer- 4738
 cise routines and to practice the martial arts. DARYL WOODS 4739
 (EDWARD IVAN MCGHEE) was in the area at the time in possession of 4740
