Source: On 07/28/04 at about 1705 hours I assisted SA T. Walbridge regarding a subject who called the FBI with information about the location of military ordnance.

Victim(s) Statements: None.

Witness(es) Statements: None.

Investigation: On 07/28/04 at about 1705 hours I was working at the FBI Joint Terrorism Task Force office. SA C. Wible advised me of a subject on the telephone with SA T. Walbridge providing information about military ordnance. The subject later identified as Garrett Floyd Holmes, DOB 05/28/71, said he found several crates of missiles and weapons while on a piece of property in the foothills east of Fresno near the community of Miramonte, CA. Holmes described the property's location and physical description of the structures on the property, which was consistent with the Muslims of the Americas (MOA) property located at 50300 Highway 245, Miramonte, CA.

Holmes advised that he had taken some items from the property that would corroborate his story. Holmes was asked to meet with SA Walbridge and myself in person to discuss this further and to view the items he had taken. A records check revealed that Holmes was on CDC Parole for VC10851 with at discharge date of 02/12/2007.

SA T. Walbridge, SA N. Arico, and I drove to Holmes' residence, located at 6460 S. Cherry Ave., Easton, CA, and interviewed Holmes at about 1832 hours. Holmes advised that a friend of his girlfriend, Shirley LNU told him there were several cars for sale on the MOA property. Shirley told him to take look at some of the vehicles because she knew the man who was the caretaker of the property and he held the titles to the vehicles.

Holmes described the property's location as being on the east side of "Dunlap Road" across the street from the CDF fire station. He said the property has a double white gate near the road, a pond near the north end of the property, runway, and numerous buildings including classrooms upon the property. The description of the property was consistent with the MOA property.

Holmes drove to the property on 07/27/2004 at about 1330 hours on his motorcycle, entering through the double white gate. Holmes advised he drove along a small road on the property stopping in front of a large blue metal warehouse style building. Holmes said the blue warehouse is located at the southern end of the property with three large roll-up bay doors on the east and west sides of the building. Holmes stated there are about 40 vehicles approximately 40 yards southeast of the building that were riddled with bullet holes. He also saw several horses in a corral east of the blue building which he described as follows: (2) bays, (2) buckskin quarter horses, (3) appaloosas, and (2) other.

Holmes advised he entered the blue warehouse on the east side via the southern bay door. Holmes advised that upon entering the building, he found several blueprints and commercial aircraft including 747s. Holmes was queried as to whether the blueprints of the aircraft were drawings/sketches or actual blueprints. Holmes advised that they were in fact actual blueprints with "747" written on the bottom of at least one of the blueprints.

Holmes further advised that he located several pieces of literature that were on the table with
