The final building checked was the front office building near the front gate. Inside this building we located a large stack of blueprints to building structures, however, during this cursory search, we did not see any blueprints for aircraft. Ghafur was asked one last time if she wanted to press charges against Holmes for burglary. Ghafur said she did not, however, she would consult with her attorney about the situation.

Based upon Holmes' statements that he entered the buildings carrying his saddlebags and a flashlight, that he spent three hours on the property, and he stated purpose that he was there to "shop" for a vehicle, I believe that Holmes entered the property with the intent to loot the vacant premises. Holmes also knowingly and intentionally misled investigators by providing false information to a peace officer. Holmes continued to mislead investigators for three days and numerous interviews. Holmes' post-polygraph interview and statements indicate that Holmes did knowingly provide this false information with the intent that law enforcement act upon that information.

It is requested that an arrest warrant be issued for Holmes for PC148.5-False information to a Peace Officer, and PC148(a)-Obstruction.
