When moving to a new location

You should change your cars license plates to correspond to the state you are now living in.

You should make sure that not to many people are living in the house or apartment that you are renting. Differebt families show up so there shouldn't be to many men and women in the residence for it will draw attention.

You should have the least possible communications with people outside your area.

All outside communications should have the approval of the officer incharge (Naib, Amir, Nazim or Sr. Talib) and one must be careful not to utilize safe names, post office boxes, addresses, or telephones when they are making contact with unsafe places and people. Remember once a mistake is made it cannot be corrected by any means other than obtaining new ID, phones, addresses, post office box etc.

Incognito dress should be neat and conservative and it should blend as much as possible with the clothes that the people in that area usually wear. Ex: Children should be neat, their hair should be combed and oiled, their clothes should be pressed without holes. The women should dress so they don't draw attention to themselves as being Muslim. Men should be clean and conservative also and when they are dres sed in work clothes they to should be neat and properly taken care of. If you are not living in a military city were where military clothes are common you shouldn't wear them. However if you do live in a military city there is no harm if you wear them as long as you don't over do it. In the winter it is very easy for women to dress incognito however in the summer it is difficult. In some areas they wear maternity tops and loose pants with hats and strips of turban.

You should already have kufr identification, drivers license, state ID cards, soci al security card, check chasing card, library card etc.

You must have references set up so youcan get a job and rent a place to stay as well as for a bank account, credit card and hospitalization. You should establish a phone connection here so that if someone calls for a reference someone on the other end will give them the proper information.

You must have enough means to obtain a job, eat, rent some place to live, acquire proper dress to meet the dress code and maintain yourself for at least six weeks.

You must have a firm contact with a Naib or an Amir so that you will be able to receive the necessary instructions and to be constantly informed of changing conditions.

You should have a good vehicle all the time. (one that can go from one side of the United States to the other at any given time - should be able to travel at top speed if necessary)

You must locate and learn the normal habits of the local law enforcemen authorities.

You must know the local means of transportation and the road ways in and out of your area. Knowledge of the buses, railroad and airports should be obtained and one should know the national and international connectys.

Older children that are school age should not be seen outside during school hours.

Younger children if you have a few should be seen playing outside with supervision so as to manifest a normal family life style.

Children should be taught what to say and what not to say when questioned by kufr. they should understand the situation. A pleasant attitude should be shown to neighbors by the adults by saying such things as "Good Morning, nice day isn't it, have a good day.

Women should be educated so that they will be able to deal with any situation that might arise when the male member of the family is out.

Women should not make contact with anyone outside the household without their husbands permission.

You should cut your ties with the kufr relatives. (*Kufr parents can't be obeyed by Law*)
You should break your ties with muslims that are not directly involved in the activities that you are and with those muslims that you are not directly responsible to.

You must make sure your family knows what it is involved in and what is expected of them.

You should train your children and keep them under your control.

No one except those that are in authority should know when and where you are about to move to. Those in authority are those who have commissioned you to move.

Secrecy is a Must!!!

You should never do anything on your own.

You should leave in a way that you are not followed, so no one can trace you and so that no one will be suspicious.

You should know exactly how to get to the area you are traveling to.

You should do as much research as possible about the place you are going to through the use of the library, magazines, newspapers and tourist guides.

You should not discuss training with any unauthorized personnel

You should not teach what you have been taught without permission.

Whatever you have been taught should be mastered so that you have perfect understanding

Whenever you are taught something you cannot change even the smallest thing without the permission of your instructor or the one in authority over him.

Whenever studying your lessons you should be in a secured area.

You should never project yourself as being part or having any knowledge of a para military organization

You should make yourself aware of all vital installations *of your area such as Gas, water, electricity, oil, Tele Exchange etc.*

You should never throw written information in the garbage

One way to check before disposing of your garbage is to check for written, typed items with important info such as names, places, telephone numbers, receipts, and return addresses. You should ever safely burn the documents or dispose of them by taking them to dumpsters in shopping centers, gas stations, rest areas and any other area that has such a facility.

Your family should blend in & with the community,

Once you enter your house you should change into muslim attire *at once.*

You should make sure you do your mamoolat

You should be constant in your employment and punctual in your arrival and be sure to pay the tax on all the wealth that the members of your family receive

You should keep curtains up to your windows

You should not obtain a phone without permission and if it is granted only those can have your number who have been cleared by whoever is in authority over you

You should remain alert

You should be prepared to go on any assignment you are given without delay. You must prepare your families for this and they shouldn't ask questions

You should be in good physical shape, *and should maintain it - doing physical exercises*
You should have a valid passport in a *kafir* name

You should know how to establish safe forms of communications. Direct dialing can be done in ~~some-air~~ most airline terminals. You should change your location regularly and it should be at least three to four miles away from your residence if you are calling a safe phone and between five to ten miles away if you are calling an unsafe phone. You must keep a strict time schedule so that you will be available at a particular phone at a particular place at a particular time for a particular period. Be prompt and always choose a stop where you will draw the least amount of attention from passers by. You should stay only as long as it takes for you to get a message and give one. You should know the codes so you can relate other telephone numbers on unsafe phones. Try not to give any ambiguous messages.

You should ^{know} how long it takes to send packages or letters from one place to another. You should know different ways of sending things so they arrive the next day. This should be done for both national and international basis. Ex. Flying Tiger, Railroad, Buses etc.

Those in authority should receive periodic calls from you and they should know how to reach you at all times.

Make sure you know what your assignment is and exactly what you are suppose to do at the same time you must know what you can do and what you cannot do

You should know information about the country you are in and what the visa requirements are. When taking a plane you should know how much luggage you can take, and how long your ticket is good for as well if there are any other stipulations

You should learn your way around and be able to function in any type of emergency

You should be very thorough in your work and conclusive in whatever you do

Never carry written documents which disclose your connections or your mission

All small notes and telephone numbers should be burned in sink. Be careful

You should have a camera capable of taking pictures of written materials so you might take pictures of documentation

Be mindful of what you say in public places and public modes of travel like buses taxis etc.

Always check to see if you are being followed, watched or bugged

Do not become paranoid

Remember you are travelling in a foreign country and you are just like any tourist

Be careful you don't become stranded or out of contact with your base

If you arrive at a foreign place and you need information about where to stay then go to the tourist desk for info

All orders should be carried out as soon as they are received unless otherwise instructed

To disobey an order is treason and will be treated as such

To disobey anyone deputed to give an order is to disobey the Sheikh, which is to disobey Nabi Akhram (Salaam and Salawat) be upon him which indeed is to disobey Allah (Astaghfirullah),

If you are giving orders make sure that the recipient understands exactly what is expected of him or her

Remember those who give orders must take them

You should find out how you can receive emergency funds

You should be aware of the weather conditions and what you must bring with you

Check your health shots.

Make sure that you are not carrying contraband

Don't take anything you don't need

You should ~~atta-~~ obtain a credit card whenever you can

If an individual is let out of jail or was questioned by authorities then they should be questioned by those in authority so as to determine what their position is

If arrested you should give no information until a lawyer is present ,
